LUNCH TIME CHECKLIST:

- After dismissal bell, please stay until halls are clear of students. Remind kids use quiet voices, no running or horseplay, and to move on to class.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- Students are not allowed to be past the student phone, past the restrooms across from the counseling center or the restrooms next to the kitchen, during the lunch period.
- Students are NOT ALLOWED to leave school grounds during the lunch period.
- Students may use the library during the lunch period, but may not linger in the hallways outside the library.
