# Minutes

- **1. Call to Order:** President Sarah Rock called the meeting to order at 7:02 PM. The attendance list was recorded on Zoom.
- **2.** Minutes & Correspondence: The minutes of the October 12, 2021 meeting were shared prior to the meeting. The minutes were approved and moved to record.
- 3. Financial Reports: The October treasurer's report was shared prior to the meeting. Treasurer Peter Madison spoke about line items of interest: new membership, donations, Panther Playhouse, and classroom grants. Peter also made note of our bank reserves. The general membership had no questions about the report.

#### 4. Business Items

### a. 2021-2022 Budget Changes

- i. The board is proposing three changes to the budget. The draft of the newly proposed budget, with the following changes, was shared with the membership prior to the meeting:
  - 1. Increasing the supplemental grant budget by \$5,000 to pay for spiritware t-shirts for all students and staff.
  - 2. Adding a budget line for the Walkabout program, with a budget of \$100.
  - 3. Increasing the Levy Donation line from \$0 to \$200.
- *ii.* Peter Madison made a motion to approve the draft budget as presented to the membership. The motion was seconded and was approved.
- b. Election for Open Office: We have an open position on the board for VP of Communications, and Sarah opened the floor for nominations. No nominations were put forth, so the matter was tabled until the January General Membership Meeting.
- **c.** Nominating Committee Election: President Sarah Rock put out a call for three members to serve on our Nominating Committee. No nominations were put forth, so the matter was tabled until the January General Membership meeting

#### 5. Reports

a. President: Sarah Rock

- i. The PTSA is partnering with the KiMS counselors to collect winter clothing. New or gently-used items may be dropped off at the front office during school hours, now through November 17.
- ii. We will work with the KiMS counselors for the Giving Tree Program: our counselors will confidentially gather wishes from KiMS students and families and create a wishlist, and anyone can sign up to fulfill a wish. Physical items can be accepted at the school; gift card donations will be accepted by the PTSA at specific times only.

## b. Membership: Joelle Harrison

- i. As of November 5, we are at 239 members, including 14 staff, which is sufficient to earn our PTSA the Silver WSPTA Membership Growth Award.
- Joelle announced the winners of our membership drawing: Jennifer Lettalleir won a \$25 to Nothing Bundt Cakes gift card and Cindy Kruse won a \$25 Coffee and Cone gift card.
